<u>Purpose</u>

This policy outlines the process for recruiting Non-Academic Professional staff as employees to perform tutoring duties.

<u>Policy</u>

- 1.0 Policy
 - 1.1 In accordance with the Letter of Agreement reached between The Governors of Athabasca University and AUFA effective August 1, 1990, the following procedures will apply where Non-academic Professional staff are hired for tutoring responsibilities. Although rates of pay are equal to those paid under CUPE, The Governors of Athabasca University/AUFA Terms and Conditions apply.
- 2.0 Roles and Responsibilities
 - 2.1 Where a non-academic professional staff member is hired to tutor a course, a tutoring contract is issued by Learning Services, Tutorial.
 - 2.2 Where a nonacademic professional staff member is hired to mark exams, a staff appointment form is completed by the academic centre and forwarded to Learning Services, Tutorial.

- 2.3 Remuneration is determined in accordance with the rates of pay outlined in the CUPE agreement.
- 2.4 Remuneration is paid on the regular payroll at the end of each month. AUFA dues are deducted.
