Licensing Examination Results

The only program at Athabasca University that can lead directly to licensure by an external agency is the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Bachelor of Nursing. This program meets the requirements of the Nursing Education Program Approval Board in Alberta. Graduates write the registration examination approved by the College & Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta (CARNA). Starting in 2015 CARNA switched to the NCLEX-RN licensing examination. In keeping with our provincial counterparts, AU does not publish institutional level results.
