The Minister confirmed that he did not wish to see any staff, whether executive or otherwise, being forced to relocate to the Town of Athabasca, and maintained his reticence at extending the deadline by which he expects the Board to sign the 2022-2025 IMA dated July 29, 2022; that being August 31, 2022. The Minister also noted his willingness to provide Athabasca University with additional funding to assist Athabasca University with its economic development goals as it relates to the Town of Athabasca.
