

1. Purpose

The Student Academic Appeals Committee is responsible for dealing with matters related to student academic misconduct.

2. Membership

The membership of the Student Academic Appeals Committee shall be:

- Chair, Registrar (non-voting, except in the case of a tie)
- Four (4) full-time academic faculty members, one (1) elected by the full-time academic faculty members from each of the Faculty of Business, the Faculty of Health Disciplines, the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, and the Faculty of Science and Technology
- One (1) full-time academic faculty member, with a graduate teaching component, from any faculty elected by the full-time academic faculty members
- One (1) undergraduate student representative chosen by the council of the students association
- One (1) graduate student representative chosen by the council of the graduate students association

3. Responsibilities

The Student Academic Appeals has the following powers and duties:

3.1 Adjudicate appeals on penalties for academic misconduct.

3.2 Adjudicate appeals on institutional procedure and policy when a policy does not specify that a University Officer has final decision making authority.

3.3 Recommend to General Faculties Council on any new policy or revisions to existing policy governing matters related to student academic misconduct and non-academic misconduct.

3.4 Where the Chair of Student Academic Appeals Committee deems it necessary, a special meeting of the Committee shall be called to deal with urgent matters.
